~Praise God for a beautiful Youth Service in June put on by our youth.

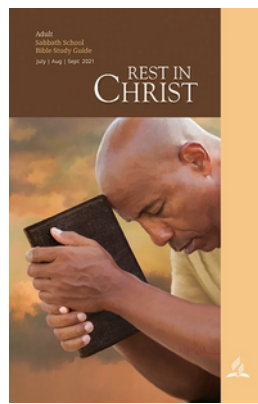
~Praise God for the musical talents in our church.
